Massachusetts Public Health Inspector (PHIT) Housing Course



A blended (online and classroom) comprehensive course, which generally takes six to nine months to complete, with a one year maximum time limit.

WHAT IS REQUIRED

1. Written supervisor approval
2. Creation of an account in the NEPHTC Learning Mgt System (LMS) and completion of pre-tests, post-tests and evaluation forms (online)
3. Completion of five elements, in this order
 - a. Four self-paced E-Learnings (requires registration in the LPHI LMS)
 - b. Three days of classroom training
 - c. One virtual training inspection
 - d. Five supervised field inspections with a field trainer
 - e. Online final assessment
