
Parts of the Environment

Things

• Includes objects that you use to complete activities.







Inside Places

- Includes spaces inside buildings and the size, shape, and layout of the space.
- Includes the spaces in between rooms or floors.








Outside Places

• Includes nature such as parks and forests, and other outdoor areas such as streets.






People

• Includes adults and friends that you talk to or interact with during activities.







Services & Organizations

 Includes schools, clubs, religious groups, offices, governments, businesses, and other groups that are in charge of organizing activities or events for people.





Rules

- Includes directions about how activities should be completed.
- Includes the amount of time given to complete activities.







Technology

 Includes computers, electronics and adaptive equipment that help people do things.





Ground

- Includes the surfaces you walk or wheel over when going places.
- Includes man-made or natural surfaces, like concrete, sand, or snow.





Entrances & Exits

 Includes all the ways to get in and out of buildings.







Signs & Information

 Includes all things that give people the facts they need to do or find things, like maps, symbols, lists, websites, brochures, or announcements.







Light, Sound & Smell

• Includes sensations such as how bright something is, how loud something is, or how something smells.
