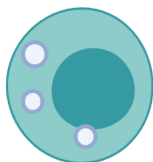


Antigen-presenting cells take antigens from the infecting viruses and present them to immune cells.

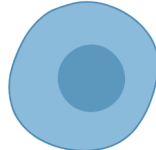


CELL-MEDIATED IMMUNITY
