An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 59B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by inserting after the word “chapter”, in line 36, the following words:- ;  
3   provided, however, that the hiring, promotion and termination of employees in custodial,  
4   maintenance and other non-teaching positions shall be conducted in accordance with any  
5   governing collective bargaining agreement.
