In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the solicitation of murder.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 15F the following section: Section 15G. Any person who, with the intent that another
- 3 commit murder, solicits, counsels, advises or otherwise entices another to commit murder shall
- 4 be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 20 years, or by imprisonment
- in the house of correction for not more than $2\frac{1}{2}$ years and a fine of not more than \$1,000.
