## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act updating the definition of fentanyl trafficking.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 32E of chapter 94C of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking subsection (c½), as inserted by chapter 136 of the acts of 2015, and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following subsection:-
- 4  $(c\frac{1}{2})$  Any person who trafficks in fentanyl or any derivative of fentanyl by knowingly or
- 5 intentionally manufacturing, distributing, dispensing or possessing with intent to manufacture,
- 6 distribute, or dispense or by bringing into the commonwealth a net weight of 10 grams or more
- but less than 18 grams of fentanyl or any derivative of fentanyl, or a net weight of 10 grams or
- 8 more but less than 18 grams of any mixture containing fentanyl or any derivative of fentanyl,
- 9 shall be punished by a term of imprisonment in state prison for not more than 20 years.
- SECTION 2. Section 32E of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting after the phrase "heroin or any salt

- thereof," each time said phrase appears in lines 80, 85, 87 and 89, the words:- "fentanyl or any
- derivative thereof,"
