Provides for the Borrowing of Money by the Commonwealth and comes within the Provisions of Section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

Provides for the taking or acquisition by purchase or otherwise of lands or other easements or such interests acquired for the purpose of protecting the people in their right to the conservation, development and utilization of the agricultural, mineral, forest, water, air and other natural resources, for other than the aforementioned purposes and comes within the provisions of Article XCVII of the Amendments to the Constitution.
