Facilitate shorter-term procurement by moderate-sized entities

Mr. Vitolo of Brookline move to amend the bill in section 11, line 205, by striking the words “to promote offshore wind innovation” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “to promote offshore wind innovation, including, without limitation, creating a dedicated fund and operating a program to secure, leverage or otherwise guarantee long-term purchases of energy and renewable energy certificates from certified offshore wind companies for direct sale, or resale by the center, to a municipality or group of municipalities with an approved municipal load aggregation plan pursuant to section 134 of chapter 164 of the general laws; non-profit aggregations pursuant to section 137 of chapter 164 of the general laws; and other private aggregations with plans approved by the Clean Energy Center”.
