## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the issuance of a permit for the temporary operation of a casino in the Commonwealth..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 commonwealth shall issue a temporary permit to conduct a full operation casino gaming
- 3 including, but not limited to, various table games and slot machines. This operation shall
- 4 conduct business similar to Foxwoods and Mohegan Sun 24 hours a day, seven days a week. All
- 5 profits estimated at \$25,000,000 per month will be turned over to the commonwealth. Any
- 6 excess profits will be deposited in a special charity account, for disbursements to qualified
- 7 commonwealth charities. A special fund will be established by the casino management to pay
- 8 for five full time monitors to be chosen by the commonwealth. The casino will operate at the

9	sole pleasure of the commonwealth from month to month and may be closed in its entirety, if and
10	when issued an order to cease in a six month period by the commonwealth.
