By Ms. Khan of Newton, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2369) of Kay Khan and others relative to certified professional midwives and enhancing the practice of nurse-midwives. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An act relative to enhancing the practice of nurse midwives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1: Subsection (g) of said section 7 of chapter 94C 8 of the general laws, as so appearing,
2 is hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
3 paragraph:

5 The commissioner shall promulgate regulations which provide for the registration of
6 certified nurse-midwives,as provided in section 80G of chapter 112, to issue written prescriptions
7 in accordance with regulations as provided for in section 80B of chapter 112. Prior to
8 promulgating such regulations, the commissioner shall consult with the board of registration in
9 nursing and the board of registration in medicine with regard to those schedules of controlled
10 substances for which certified nurse-midwives may be registered.

11 SECTION 2. Section 80C of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

13 SECTION 3. Said chapter 112, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition is hereby amended by
14 striking out section 80G and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

15 Section 80G. A nurse authorized to practice as a certified nurse-midwife

16 may order and interpret tests, therapeutics and prescribe medications in accordance with

17 regulations promulgated by the board and subject to the provisions of subsection (g) of section 7

18 of chapter 94C.”
