The General Laws are hereby further amended by Inserting after chapter 128C the following chapter: Chapter 128D. Establishing Casinos in Massachusetts.

SECTION 1. General Provisions.

- (a) This chapter shall be known and may be cited as "Casinos in Massachusetts Act"
- (b) No applicant for a gaming license, or a manufacturer's or distributor's license or other affirmative commission approval has any right to a license or the granting of the approval sought. Any license issued or other commission approval granted pursuant to the provisions of this act is a revocable privilege, and no holder acquire any vested right therein or there under.
- (c) Nothing in this chapter shall preclude any city or town in the commonwealth from prohibiting gaming.
