AN ACT ESTABLISHING EXPANDED GAMING IN THE FRAMESHWELLTH.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this set would tend to defeat it purpose, which is forthwith to provide for sechemic investments and jureation in the commonwealth, therefore, it is hereby declared to be emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the publiconvenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Espresentatives in General C assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fellows:

SECTION 1. To provide for certain unenticipated obligations of commonwealth, to provide for an alteration of purpose for curappropriations, and to meet certain requirements of law, the sums set for section 2A are hereby appropriated from the General Fund, unless specified designated otherwise, for the several purposes and subject to the compactified in this section, and subject to laws regulating the disburse public funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012; provided, however notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, appropriate herein shall not revert and shall be available for expenditure until 30, 2013. The sums shall be in addition to any amounts previously appared made available for the purposes of these items.
