THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

AN ACT ESTABLISHING EXPANDED GAMING IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat purpose, which is forthwith to provide for economic investments and job creation in the commonwealth, therefore, it is hereby declared to be emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for certain unanticipated obligations of the commonwealth, to provide for an alteration of purpose for certain appropriations, and to meet certain requirements of law, the sums set forth in section 2A are hereby appropriated from the General Fund, unless specifically designated otherwise, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this section, and subject to laws regulating the disbursement of public funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012; provided, however, notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, appropriations made herein shall not revert and shall be available for expenditure until June 30, 2013. The sums shall be in addition to any amounts previously appropriated and made available for the purposes of these items.

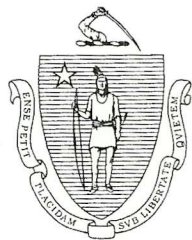
