CHAPTER 134 AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MASSACHUSETTS FIRE TRAINING COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 164 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the word "ten" and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- 12.

SECTION 2. Said section 164 of said chapter 6, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "chief", in line 17, the following words:- ; 2 of whom shall be selected from a list of 4 names submitted by the Massachusetts Call and Volunteer Firefighters Association.

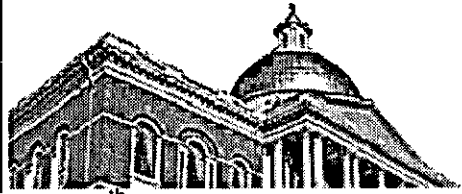
