Help us test the safety of a **soft assistive suit** designed to help people with stroke walk faster, farther, and with less effort!

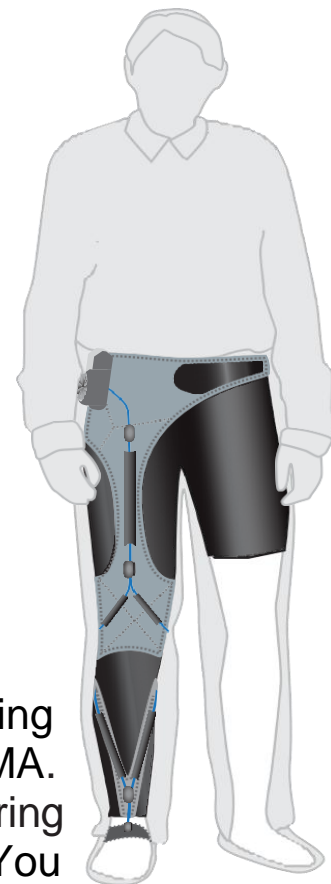
Investigators from Boston University and Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital are studying a soft wearable suit designed to help people who have had a stroke walk independently.
