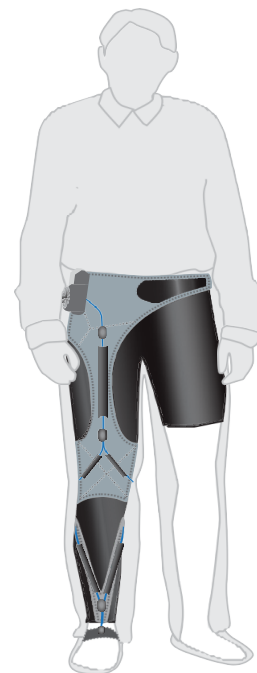
Your help is needed for the design and development of a soft lower extremity assistive suit

The Wyss Institute at Harvard is developing a soft wearable suit to improve walking and the independence of mobility-impaired stroke survivors.

We are looking for individuals who:

- Are between 25-80 years old
- Have been diagnosed with a stroke by a physician
- Do not have any serious conditions that may interfere with ability to participate in this research
 - For example, conditions affecting your muscles, skin, vasculature, or heart, or a history of visual, vestibular, or balance disorders
- Are able to understand, communicate, and be understood by research staff

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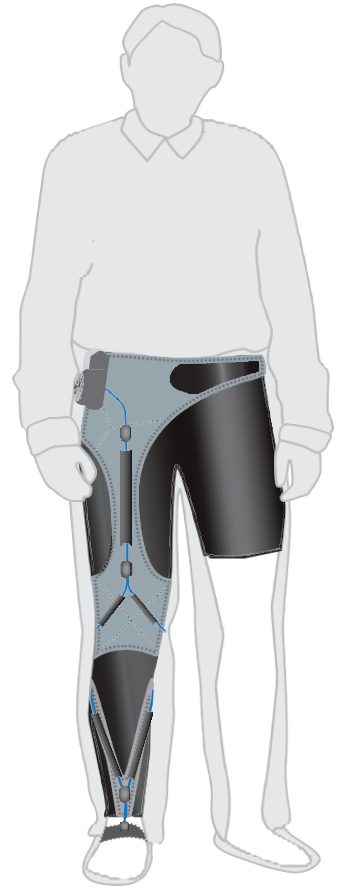
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
