Free gait training

Receive gait training provided by a Physical Therapist at no cost to you. Your insurance will not be billed. Gait training is based on best practices and individualized to your needs.

Soft robotic exosuit

Some people in this study will train with a next generation soft wearable robot (called **Exosuits**). The exosuit helps your weaker leg as you walk and makes walking easier*.

Compensation

You will receive up to \$120 for travel expenses and \$300 for evaluations. And free parking!

- Age > 18 years
- Stroke > 6 months ago
- Able to walk without help
