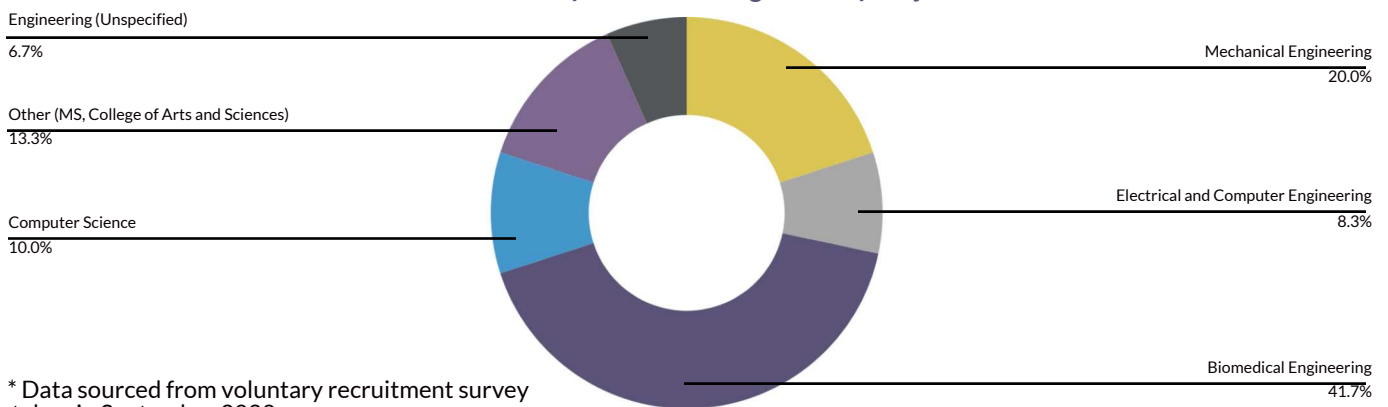
## About SWE
