- ✓ Starting in April 2017, VCS held monthly meetings
- ✓ Membership includes faculty and staff from CRC and MED Campus
 - New members from Audit, CELOP, DAR, Digital Learning, Disability Services, Distance Ed, EdTech, IS&T, Libraries, PAFO, School of Medicine, School of Public Health, Sourcing and Procurement
