Baseline Assessment

Instrument

- 1) Demographics
- 2) Short Form Health Survey (SF-12) + 4 questions from the Medical Outcomes Study HIV Health Survey (MOS-HIV)
- 3) The Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MOCA) – selected questions
- 4) HIV Symptom Index + MOCA Recall
- 5) Treatment, Healthcare Utilization and Trauma
- 6) Calcium Intake/Food History Questionnaire
- 7) Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT-C)
- 8) 30-day Timeline Follow-Back (TLFB) Alcohol and ASI 30-Day Drug + 3 questions
- 9) Opioids + Craving
- 10) Short Inventory of Problems- Alcohol (SIP)
- 11) Short Inventory of Problems- Drugs (SIP-D)
- 12) HIV Medication History
- 13) HIV Risk Categorization
- 14) HIV Risk Behaviors
- 15) Depression- Patient Health Questionnaire (PHQ-2)
- 16) Overdose History
- 17) Smoking Questions
- 18) Physical Activity Questions + Running/Jogging
- 19) Brief Pain Inventory (BPI)
- 20) Overall Anxiety Severity and Impairment Scale (OASIS)
- 21) Additional Bone Questions

Biological Samples

- 1) Serum and plasma (CD4 count, platelet count, hemoglobin, HIV viral load, ALT/AST, creatinine, HBV surface antibody, HBV core antibody, HBV surface antigen, HCV antibody, 25-hydroxy-vitamin D)
- 2) Dried blood spots
