	<b><i>Administered Assessment</i></b>	<b><i>Description</i></b>
1.	<b>Demographics</b>	Participant demographics and socio-economic status
2.	<b>HIV Testing</b>	Asks when they first test positive for HIV
3.	<b>ART Medication History and Adherence</b>	History and current use of ART, VAS for adherence
4.	<b>Resource Utilization</b>	Assesses hospital stays
5.	<b>Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT)</b>	Identifies persons with hazardous alcohol use during the past year
6.	<b>DSM-5 Alcohol Use Disorder</b>	Diagnosis of alcohol use disorders, with classifications of mild, moderate, and severe
7.	<b>30-day Alcohol Timeline Followback (TLFB)</b>	Estimates of participant's daily drinking over the past 30 days
8.	<b>Penn Alcohol Craving Scale</b>	Instrument for assessing alcohol craving. Measures frequency, intensity, and duration of thoughts about drinking, as well as ability to resist drinking
9.	<b>Readiness to Quit Alcohol</b>	Assesses readiness to quit drinking via a readiness to change ruler
10.	<b>Tobacco Use (Fagerström)</b>	A measure of nicotine dependence
11.	<b>HIV Risk Categories</b>	Asks about participant's potential exposure to HIV
12.	<b>Depressive Symptoms (CESD-10)<sup>8</sup></b>	A measure of depressive symptomology
13.	<b>Anxiety (GAD-7)</b>	Measure of severity of anxiety
14.	<b>Co-Morbidities</b>	Participant and family medical history
15.	<b>Brief Pain Inventory (SF)</b>	Assesses the severity of pain and its impact on functioning
16.	<b>Medications</b>	Prescription and non-prescription medication taken in the past 7 days
17.	<b>Drug Use</b>	Participant's self-reported drug use, modified to adapt to drug practices in Uganda and questions regarding history of overdose
18.	<b>Social Support Scale</b>	Measures access to companionship, assistance, or other types of support
19.	<b>Veterans Rand 12-Item Health Survey</b>	Assessment of overall health
20.	<b>Symptoms/events Checklist</b>	Assesses baseline and follow-up symptoms
