

These Boobs Made for Walking



Artist Talk

Sohyoung Park is a multidisciplinary artist based in Boston, New York, and Seoul. She is currently in the MFA program in sculpture at Boston University. “These Boobs Made for Walking” is a video of five women talking about their desires. Their faces are cut out of the frame, with a new face superimposed over the torso of each. Ms. Color Pack is an artistic persona with her own Instagram who is brave enough to talk about personal freedom for women worldwide. She is the leader of the “The Walking Boobs”, a feminist coalition. She emphasizes the need for an alliance of women who collectively share their wisdom and expertise in the interest of realizing political and social change. This alliance is based on mutual personal affinity rather than biologically determined identity, with the ultimate goal of building an ecofeminist, post-digital utopia inclusive to all regardless of gender, race, class, and species. My personal experiences as an international woman inform my concerns about identity within and beyond my studio practice.
